These wetlands are approximately 5 feet higher in elevation above the unnamed stream and are separated by open fields, and a city road. These wetlands do not abut a TNW, lake, pond, or impoundment of a jurisdictional water in a typical year; and are not inundated by flooding from any waterbody. This is confirmed by a review of FEMA Flood Hazard Zones map and National Hydrography Dataset (USGS). Therefore, these wetlands do not meet the definition of an adjacent wetland under the NWPR and are not waters of the US.
