Explain: The 13.1 acre review area contains one wetland (Wetland 1) which is 1.65 acres in size. The majority of the review area consists of the demolished Wind Point School facility and playground. Prior to school construction in the 1950's, the entire property was utilized for row crop agriculture since at least 1937. In 1978, a portion of the the school playground was graded and a stormwater basin was constructed in an upland area to service a residential development. Based on analysis of multiple years of aerial photography and the August 2018 Heartland Ecological Group, Inc. Wetland Delineation Report, the Corps has determined that Wetland 1 was constructed in an upland area and formed within the perimeter of the constructed stormwater basin.

In accordance with the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations, Wetland 1 is not within the Corps jurisdiction since the Corps does not generally consider the following to be waters of the U.S.; artificial lakes or ponds created by excavating and/or diking dry land to collect and retain water and which are used exclusively for such purposes as stock watering, irrigation, settling basins or rice growing. In addition, Corps regulations at 328.3(a)(8) specifically excludes waste treatment systems, including treatment ponds or lagoons designed to meet the requirements of the CWA from being waters of the US.
