The Lidar and NHD maps in the delineation report as well as the National Wetlands Inventory Maps indicate that Stormpond 1 was constructed in either upland or a non-jurisidictional water as a stormwater control feature. Therefore Stompond 1 meets the (b)(10) exclusion under the NWPR and is not a water of the US (WOUS).
Wetland 1	0.66 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	The nearest (a)(1)-(a)(3) water is Clearwater Creek
Wetland 1A	0.02 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	approximately 0.18 miles north of Wetlands 1 and 1A. Wetland 1 is connected to Wetland 1A (Wetland 4a from 2016 delineation report) via culvert. According to the 2016 delineation report, Wetland 4 is a ditch broken into three wetlands (4a, 4b, and 4c) Wetland 4a is separated from Wetland 4b by an access road with Wetland 4c being a small constructed stormwater/swale feature at the north end of the ditch. The boundaries of Wetland 4c from the 2016 delineation report indicate that Wetland 4c is not a relocated tributary and does not have a surface water connection to Clearwater Creek therefore Wetlands 1 and 1A do not meet the definition of adjacent wetlands. Wetlands 1 and 1A do not abut a TNW, lake, pond, or impoundment of a jurisdictional water in a typical year and are not waters of the US (WOUS) under the NWPR rule.
