
# Sector UMR area of responsibility:

- 33 locks & dams, 238bridges & 7 majorpopulation centers





















# Buoy Tender Recapitalization Project Update

- 2021 Inland buoy tender RFP release
- 2021 River buoy tender/inland construction tender contract award
- 2022 Inland buoy tender contract award
- 2025 Initial operational capability (IOC)

   achieved following post-delivery
  availability, test and evaluation, and
  certification that the first hull of each
  WCC variant satisfies all key performance
  parameters, or threshold requirements
  without which the ATON mission cannot be
  performed.
- 2030 Full operational capability (FOC) achieved following delivery and shakedown of the last cutter.




From top: notional Coast Guard indicative designs of the river buoy tender, inland construction tender, and inland buoy tender
