

EAU GALLE PROJECT - AREAS

Main Day Use Area (168 acres)

Picnic areas, 2 shelters (East and West) that can be reserved for large gatherings, and I Shelter (Bay Shelter) that is first come, first-served basis. Open spaces for playing, 2 horseshoe pits, boat landing and piers, universally accessible fishing pier, 3 playgrounds, 3 sand volleyball courts, beach area, approximately 2 miles of hiking trails, overlooks, shoreline fishing, and ice fishing in the winter.

Northwest Day Use Area (83 acres)

Located at the end of Boston Road, trailhead parking for equestrian and hiking trails, great shoreline fishing along the Eau Galle River and Lake, picnic areas, a non-reservable shelter (Ox Shelter), area can also be accessed by hiking down Ox trail from the campground.

Highland Ridge Campground (132 acres) Campsites include; electric, non-electric, walk-in tent sites, and group campsites, interpretive programs are presented all summer long on the weekends, there are several miles of multi-use hiking and equestrian trails. Enjoy exploring winding trails through dense forests, open prairies, and scenic overlooks.

Equestrian Campground Loop has 10 non-electric sites with access to 7 miles of hiking and equestrian trails.

Lousy Creek Landing (89 acres)

Located close to the campgrounds at the end of County Rd. NN, parking trailhead for hiking and equestrian trails, boat ramp.

Stilling Basin (38 acres)

The Stilling Basin is a great place to view the out flow of water from the reservoir into the Eau Galle River. This area has picnic opportunities and is a great location for shoreline fishing along the Eau Galle River.

Lake, River and Streams (139 acres) Lake George is a wonderful location for fishing, kayaking, and swimming. The reservoir, river, and streams are home to numerous species of fish including but not limited to; largemouth bass, bluegill, black crappie, perch, and northern pike, with brook trout in the Eau Galle River. Due to the size and depth of the reservoir only electrically powered motors are permitted.




EAU GALLE PROJECT - LAKE GEORGE DEPTH SURVEY


