W-1	0.04	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland.	W-1 is a wet meadow depression within a disturbed area of a former mined site. The wetland is surrounded on all sides by upland, as shown by the delineation report and confirmed by the lack of hydric soils (gravel fill), absence of Wisconsin Wetland Inventory polygon, and general position in the landscape of a formerly mined area.  The nearest tributary is the Fox River, approximately 570 feet to the northwest and at least 5 feet lower in elevation. Based on FEMA's National Flood Hazard Layer, W-1 is in the Area of Minimal Flood Hazard; therefore, it would not be flooded by an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water in a typical year.  There are no artificial or natural barriers separating W-1 from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water as the wetland is surrounded entirely by delineated upland.
