There are no natural or artificial berms, banks, dunes, dikes or similar features physically separating them from a paragraph (a)(1)-(3) water. They are not within a floodplain. Wetland B has two outlets. There is stormwater culvert in the southern portion of Wetland B; a Google Earth review depicts only a small, ephemeral tributary. There is also a culvert in the northeastern portion of Wetland B that drains into a swale to the east. Based on the United States Geologic Survey and elevation contours, Wetland B would not be flooded by an (a)(1)-(3) water in a typical year. The only outlet from wetland A is through overland sheet flow; this wetland would also not be flooded by an (a)(1)-(3) water in a typical year. Therefore, these wetlands do not fall under Corps jurisdiction under the NWPR.
