Wetland 2	0.22 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	appears to have a surface water connection to Marsh Lake, which is located 2.47 miles southeast of the AJD review area. The boundaries described in the delineation report confirm that Wetland 2 has no surface connection to the ditch or wetland adjacent to it. The delineation report also confirms most of the boundary of Wetland 1 and aerial imagery in Google Maps was used to confirm the boundaries of the portion of Wetland 1 that continued offsite and that it had no surface connection to any waters of the US (WOUS). The delineation report along with aerial imagery confirmed that Wetlands 1 and 2 are entirely surrounded by uplands and therefore meet the definition of Non-adjacent Wetlands by the NWPR and are not waters of the US (WOUS).
