W-2 W-3	0.01	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland.	W-2 extends outside of the review area south and north of CTH Q. The March 6, 2020 AJD (2017-00036-AJK) concluded that the wetland north of CTH Q (labeled W-4 in that delineation) was non-jurisdictional, and evaluated the area south of CTH Q for a potential connection to a jurisdictional water; none were observed. The area north and south of W-2 was reviewed again to evaluate any changes, but it is still not connected to, and would not be flooded by, an a(1)-a(3) water. The nearest tributary to W-2 and W-3 is approximately 8,500 feet to the east. W-3 extends south of the review area, but based on a review of aerial photography, NWI, WWI, topographic maps, and soils maps, W-3 is surrounded by upland and would not be flooded by an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water in a typical year. There are no natural berms, banks, dunes, or similar natural features physically separating W-2 or W-3 from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water, and they are not physically separated from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water by an artificial dike, barrier, or similar artificial structure.
W-1 W-4 W-6	0.12 0.01 0.01	acre(s)	(b)(5) Ditch that is not an (a)(1) or (a)(2) water, and those portions of a ditch constructed in an (a)(4) water that do not satisfy the conditions of (c)(1).	These features are roadside ditches that were constructed in upland to convey localized runoff. Based on aerial photography, ground level site photographs, National Wetland Inventory, Wisconsin Wetland Inventory, and topographic maps, these ditches carry no more than ephemeral flow and do not relocate a tributary, are not constructed in a tributary, and are not constructed in an adjacent wetland. In the March 6, 2020 AJD (2017-00036-AJK), W-1 was reviewed for possible connections to a water of the U.S. (an a(1)-a(3) water under NWPR) and none were observed.
W-5	0.06	acre(s)	(b)(8) Artificial lake/pond constructed or excavated in upland or a non-jurisdictional	Based on the delineation report, W-5 is a pond constructed sometime between 2016-2017. A review of aerial photographs, soils maps, and topography shows that the site may have exhibited wetland history prior to 2016 based on wet signatures and hydric soil; however, the

<sup>5</sup> Because of the broad nature of the (b)(1) exclusion and in an effort to collect data on specific types of waters that would be covered by the (b)(1) exclusion, four sub-categories of (b)(1) exclusions were administratively created for the purposes of the AJD Form. These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.
