Based on United States Geologic Survey (USGS) and elevation contours, the wetlands would not be inundated by flooding from a paragraph (a)(1)-(3) water in a typical year. There are no natural berms, banks, dunes, or similar natural features separating the wetlands from (a)(1) –(a)(3) water. In addition, the wetlands are not physically separated from an (a)(1) – (a)(3) water by an artificial dike, culvert, flood gate, pump or similar artificial structure. NHD and NWI maps confirm no surface hydrological connection to the wetlands. Therefore, the wetlands do not meet the definition of an adjacent wetland under the NWPR and are not waters of the US.
