Wetland B is not separated from an a(1)-(3) water by a natural or artificial feature nor does it have direct hydrological surface connection in a typical year. Wetland B is completely surrounded by upland. The flood zone for the nearest tributary is not mapped. However, the nearest a(1)-(3) water is over 700 feet north along a topographic change of over 4 feet, the feature would not flood any part of the review area in a typical year. The nearest a(1)-(3) water is separated by a manmade feature with no artificial or natural feature connecting it to the site.			
Wetland C1	0.013	acre(s)	(b)(5) Ditch that is not an (a)(1) or (a)(2) water, and those portions of a ditch constructed in an (a)(4) water that do not satisfy the conditions of (c)(1).	Roadside ditch constructed in uplands. No aerial photos were available without Linden Oaks Drive, the oldest aerial photos from 1974 show the ditch constructed. The toe slope was constructed to support runoff from the pavement, there is an elevation change of almost 4 feet from the street to the ditch.
