## **SECTION II: SUMMARY OF FINDINGS**

#### A. RHA SECTION 10 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

### B. CWA SECTION 404 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no"waters of the U.S." within Clean Water Act (CWA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 328) in the review area.

#### 2. Non-regulated waters/wetlands (check if applicable):1

Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: The review area includes one wetland feature which is identified as "Wetland 2" on the attached figures labeled MVP-2021-01628-SJW: Page 1 of 2 through 2 of 2. According to the wetland delineation report which was submitted as part of the Approved Jurisdictional Determination (AJD) request, Wetland 2 (1,287 square feet) is a depressional forested wetland surrounded entirely by uplands. A review of the Wisconsin Wetland Inventory (WWI) mapping does not show any mapped wetlands within the delineated limits of Wetland 2. However, as indicated in the wetland delineation report, Wetland 2 exhibits hydrophytic vegetation, hydric soil, and wetland hydrology, and therefore meets wetland criteria. There are no mapped hydric soils within or in close proximity to Wetland 2, further suggesting that this feature is an isolated wetland surrounded entirely by uplands. The nearest waterbody (Lake Michigan) is located approximately 0.07 miles to the east of Wetland 2, and there are no observable inlets/outlets which would suggest that this wetland feature may maintain a hydrological connection to a downstream TNW. A review of additional available resources including aerial imagery dating back to the year 2008 and topographic mapping suggest that these wetland features do not maintain a surface or shallow subsurface hydrologic connection or an ecologic connection to a downstream TNW, nor are they separated from other WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers, or berms. As previously stated, Lake Michigan (TNW) is located approximately 0.07 miles to the east of Wetland 2. However, the area in between these two aquatic resources is comprised entirely of uplands, eliminating the potential for a hydrologic connection. Given the existing and surrounding landscape characteristics and proximity to other waters, there is no hydrologic connection between Wetland 2 and other jurisdictional wetlands or waters. Wetland 2 does not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce, is not used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes, does not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce, and is not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Therefore, the

Corps has determined that Wetland 2 is an isolated wetland feature that is not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
