D. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD: The review area for this determination is limited to the boundaries of eight roadside ditches labeled as Linear Ditch #1A&B (WD#1), Linear Ditch #2A-F (WD#2), Linear Ditch #3A-D (WD#3), Linear Ditch #4A-D (WD#4), Linear Ditch #6 (WD#6), Linear Ditch #7A&B (WD#7), Linear Ditch #11 (WD#11), and Linear Ditch #12 (WD#12) on the attached figures and tables labeled MVP-2018-01743-BGO MnDOT SP 4812-91/TH 169 & CSAH 11 AJD Attachments, Pages 1-9 of 9. Please note that this determination does not include WL#1, WL#2, WL#3, WD#8, WD#9, WD#13, WD#14 or WD#15, which are also shown on the attached figures. The total area of non-jurisdictional waters/features is approximately 1.60 acres.

The ditches are constructed features that are not relocated tributaries, are not excavated in a tributary, and do not convey perennial or intermittent flow. This was confirmed by reviewing aerial photography, national hydrography data, and the June 2018 wetland delineation report. Based on this review, the evaluated ditches are not jurisdictional under the 2015 Clean Water Rule because they meet the terms of paragraph (b)(3)(i).

¹ In many cases these excluded features will not be specifically identified on the approved JD form, unless specifically requested. Corps Districts may, in case-by-case instances, choose to identify some or all of these features within the review area.
