Explain: Within the approximate 1.5-acre project area, Wetland L (0.59 acre), was determined to be a stormwater detention basin and was constructed in uplands around 2006 and is not a water of the U.S. This was confirmed by reviewing aerial photographs dated 1937, 1963, 1967, 1970, 1975, 1990, 1995, 2000 and 2010, WWI, and the NRCS Soil Survey data. A 2004 grading and drainage plan was provided by the applicant that shows the proposed grading and inlet and outlet structures associated with a stormwater detention basin. The non-jurisdictional determination for this stormwater detention basin is in accordance with the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (33 CFR Parts 320-330), which states that the Corps does not generally consider the following to be waters of the U.S.; artificial lakes or ponds created by excavating and/or diking dry land to collect and retain water and which are used exclusively for such purposes as stock watering, irrigation, settling basins or rice growing.
