There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional.

Explain: **The review area contains 1 intrastate wetland: Wetland A. This wetland was previously determined to be isolated, non-jurisdictional wetland per an approved jurisdictional determination dated February 11, 2013 under MVP-2012-05743-MHK. A review of the 2018 Thompson & Associates wetland delineation report, previous 2013 approved jurisdictional determination, and aerial photos from 2011 to present indicate that this is still an isolated water with no surface or shallow subsurface connection to waters of the U.S. The basin is smaller in size than the last delineation in 2012. The Pewaukee River is the closest waterway which is approximately 915 feet to the east. This water does not border, neighbor nor is contiguous with another water of the U.S. The wetland is not separated from other WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers, or berms. This wetland is outside of the 100-year floodplain and within a residential development separating it from the Pewaukee River. The disturbance of surrounding land uses precludes an ecological connection to a WOUS.**

This aquatic resource does not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; is not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; does not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and is not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Therefore, the Corps has determined that this wetland is not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
