A. RHA SECTION 10 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

B. CWA SECTION 404 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no"waters of the U.S." within Clean Water Act (CWA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 328) in the review area.

 - Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: The review areas contains five intrastate wetlands (W-02, W-04, W-01/W-05, W-08, and W-11) that are not waters of the U.S. This was confirmed by reviewing the Surface Water Data Viewer (SWDV), Google Earth, Racine County aerials and topographic map, and the May, August, and October 2018 Cardno wetland delineation reports. The wetlands are located in agricultural fields east of I-94 and are not mapped in the SWDV. A unnamed tributary to the Kilbourn Road Ditch is located appoximately 190 feet south of W-02 and 325 feet north of W-04. No inlets or outlets to W-02, W-04, W-01/W-05, W-08 and W-11 are visible in any of the aerial photos reviewed from 2000-2018.

Wetlands W-02, W-04, W-01/W-05, W-08 and W-11 are isolated with no surface or shallow sub-surface connection to jurisdictional waters. They are not bordering, neighboring or contiguous with another water of the U.S. and are not separated from other WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers, or berms. The surrounding land use is dominated by agricultural fields. The disturbance of surrounding land uses precludes an ecological connection to a WOUS. These wetlands do not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; are not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; do not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and are not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Therefore, the Corps has determined that W-02, W-04, W-01/W-05, W-08, and W-11 are not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
