- Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: **This JD is for three aquatic features identified as Wet Ditch 1 (0.441 acre), Wet Ditch 2 (0.03 acre), and Wet Ditch 9 (0.068 acre) which are located in roadside ditches created in upland and are not waters of the U.S. This was confirmed by reviewing the 2016 SEWRPC wetland delineation report, Milwaukee County aerials, Google Earth aerials and ground level photos. The roadside ditches were created in upland when the roadway County Trunk Highway M (North Avenue) was constructed. CTH M (North Avenue) was constructed sometime before 1941. The ditches do not have a relatively permanent flow of water. The determination of no jurisdiction for the ditches is in accordance with the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (33 CFR Parts 320-330), which states that the Corps does not generally consider the following to be waters of the U.S.; non-tidal drainage and irrigation ditches excavated on dry land. Further clarification is provided in the December 2, 2008 Revised Guidance on Clean Water Act Jurisdiction following the Supreme Court Decision in Rapanos v. U.S. and Carabell v. U.S. issued jointly by the Corps and EPA, which indicates that ditches excavated wholly in and draining only uplands and that do not carry a relatively permanent flow of water are not waters of the United States. Therefore, the Corps has determined that Wet Ditches 1, 2 and 9 are not regulated by the Corp under Section 404 of the CWA.**
