Joseph M. Willging has served as chief of the Office of Counsel for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, St. Paul District, since June 2008. Prior to coming to the Corps of Engineers, Willging was an associate deputy general counsel in the Office of the Army General Counsel from December 2005 until June 2008, providing advice to senior Army Secretariat officials in all areas of environmental law.

From 2003 to 2005 he practiced in the Office of the Deputy General Counsel, Environment and Installations, Office of the Secretary of Defense. In May of 2003, Willging retired from active duty in the United States Air Force in the grade of colonel (O-6). Prior to his retirement, he served as chief of the Environmental Law and Litigation Division, Civil Law and Litigation Directorate, Air Force Legal Services Agency, Washington, D.C.

Willging, a St. Paul native, received his bachelor's degree from the College of St. Thomas, St. Paul, Minn., in 1978, and his Juris Doctorate from the William Mitchell College of Law, St. Paul, Minn., in 1981. In 1991, he earned a Master of Laws degree in environmental law from The National Law Center, George Washington University, Washington, D.C.
