NOTES:

1. SEED ALL DISTURBED AREAS WITH WNDOT MIXTURE 308-WF-1 SEED MIX.
2. CLEAR AND GRUB AS NECESSARY TO ACCOMMODATE THE TRAIL AND RECREATION IMPROVEMENTS.
3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT USE COMPLETED BIKE PATHS AS HAUL ROADS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REPAIR ANY DAMAGE TO COMPLETED BIKE PATHS AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE.
4. COORDINATE WITH OTHER CONTRACTORS WORKING IN THE AREAS OF THE PROJECT. FOR DETAILS, SEE EAST GRAND FORKS - PHASE 4 REFERENCE DRAWINGS.
5. CONTRACTOR STAGING AND PARKING AREAS SHALL BE WITHIN THE IDENTIFIED WORK LIMITS AND SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE CONTRACTING OFFICER.
6. TOPSOIL SHALL BE NATIVE MATERIAL STRIPPED PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND STOCKPILED FOR LATER PLACEMENT. IF CONTRACTOR FAILS TO CONSERVE MATERIAL, OR IF SUFFICIENT NATIVE TOPSOIL DOES NOT EXIST TO PROVIDE THE SPECIFIED THICKNESS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH SUPPLEMENTAL TOPSOIL FROM BORROW SOURCES ARRANGED AND PAID FOR BY THE CONTRACTOR.
